Truett McConnell University (TMU) Rielin & Salmen School of Nursing (RSSON) BSN Program is accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE). RSSON is scheduled for a CCNE Site Evaluation October 21 – 23, 2020.
